

# SHEWASHAN SCHOOL REFURBISHMENT KURDISTAN



GPK, a 75% owned subsidiary of New Age, has supported the local community with several projects in the Ashti province of the Kurdistan region of Iraq. These include environmental management programmes, infrastructure projects, school renovations and supporting local students with school materials.

In 2016 the company engaged a local contractor to renovate the school in Shewashan village. The school was in need of repair with severe water damage, cracks in walls, poor electrics and bathroom facilities.

The project involved civil works, upgrading sanitation including drainage and installing new sanitation equipment, plastering, painting and renewing electrics at a cost of US\$53,000.



Stationery, backpacks and uniforms were also supplied to the 75 students.
